VINEET JOHNSINGH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS IN INDIA STUDIES

Applications are invited for scholarships for undergraduate students taking courses in India Studies during academic year 2011-2012.

The annual Vineet Johnsingh scholarship is given to a student who demonstrates outstanding academic accomplishment or potential and promise of contribution to the fostering of a better understanding of Indian civilization.

Award: \$750

Qualifications:

- a. Must be a full-time undergraduate student at Stony Brook.
- b. Minimum GPA of 3.5.
- c. Students with demonstrated financial need will receive preference.

Requirements:

- a. Must have passed at least one course in India Studies with a grade of B+ or above prior to application.
- b. Active involvement in or contribution to India related campus activities is desirable.

Procedure:

- a. Fill out the application form available from the Center for India Studies or via the Center's website: www.stonybrook.edu/india.
- b. Attach a formal or informal transcript.
- c. Submit a personal statement of interest and involvement in India Studies.
- d. Attach a sealed letter of recommendation from a faculty member.
- e. Attach evidence of financial need, if any.

Deadline: Submit completed forms with attachments to the Center for India Studies by **April 12, 2012**. Awards will be announced by the last day of class.
