Next Meeting: Our next meeting will be on held Friday, February 7, 2020 at 11am in the Provost's Conference Room. (407 Administration Building)

Our guest speaker will be Styliani-Ann (Stella) Tsirka, PhD, Professor of Pharmacological Sciences:

Topic: "The History of Greek-Americans on Long Island"

Stella will be discussing Greeks and Greek Americans on Long Island: when they arrived to the US, where they settled, how they connected and integrated into the US culture, and how they maintain customs and traditions from their hometowns and home country.

Bio: Dr. Tsirka served for eleven years as Graduate Program Director for the Molecular and Cellular Pharmacology Program, twice renewing its NIH T32 training grant, and being involved in all aspects of the graduate program. She initiated, organized and directs the Advanced Graduate Certificate in Scholars of BioMedical Sciences, and secured NIH T32 training support for it. Dr. Tsirka participated on panels exploring ways to increase women and under-represented minority representation in STEM, she is a member of the WISE (Women in Science and Engineering) Working committee, and of Women in Neuroscience for the Society for Neuroscience. Between 2014 and 2019, she served as Vice Provost for Faculty Affairs, and in that capacity oversaw recruitment and retention of faculty, academic appointments and awards, faculty development and mentoring, promotions and tenure, academic affairs and space. She serves the Secretary/Treasurer of the NeuroPharmacology Division of The American Society for Pharmacology and Experimental Therapeutics (ASPET). She also serves as the acting Director of the Center for Hellenic Studies at SBU, organizing lectures, events and a film weekend to promote Hellenism.
