Until I moved to Stony Brook in 1994, the only Ph.D. students I had were in the context of supervising students attending various free-standing clinical psychology graduate schools in the San Francisco Bay Area. During this period I supervised the dissertations of 20 such students, six of which led to publications in peer-reviewed journals (something very rare for students from these schools whose research training is minimal and whose goals are clinical practice), and one of them (Tucker, 1999) was a Dissertation Prize Finalist for the International Network on Personal Relationships (all other finalists were from regular research universities). I believe all 20 were subsequently licensed as clinical psychologists, and those with whom I have had subsequent contact are all in successful private practice.
