Resolutions on Protest and Policing

WHEREAS President McInnis and senior administration have responded to peaceful protests on our campus with a disproportionate degree of force, failing to negotiate with students in good faith and deploying Suffolk County Police and New York States Troopers to arrest members of the Stony Brook community.

BE IT RESOLVED that the University Senate calls on our senior administration to drop all charges against the faculty, students, and community members arrested on Mar 26 and May 1 or 2; to pay to have all records of their arrests expunged; to drop all disciplinary sanctions against the arrested students and faculty; to cease disciplinary actions against or investigations into faculty, students, and student groups involved in the protests; and to grant amnesty to all participating in these actions.
